



DOWNTOWN SAFETY PATROL - *Goals and Objectives 2010*

Crime Reductions Goals

- Maintain a High Visibility presence in the Main Street Corridor.
- Participate in Joint Task Force Operations including panhandling abatement, truancy initiatives, and homeless sweeps in cooperation with DPD and DART.
- Decrease BMV and Auto related Thefts in the Central Business District.
- Attend Daily DPD Briefings, DSDA, Farmers Market, Bridge, and Residence Council Meetings. Focus intensified patrol strategy in crime problem areas.
- Establish Agreements with Downtown liquor and convenience stores that sell cheap high alcohol content drinks to the homeless.
- Distribute BOLO Crime Alerts and the Weekly Top 20 Criminal Mug Shots to Downtown Stakeholders; businesses, buildings, parking garages.

Enforce Quality of Life Ordinances

- Enforce Criminal Trespass Affidavits on file for businesses and buildings, move homeless persons to the Bridge.
- Zero tolerance policy on panhandling.
- Decrease open container/public intoxication in Parks and at the West End DART Station.

Downtown Emergency Preparedness Goals

- Facilitate Quarterly DERT Meetings/Table Top Exercises with Downtown Property Managers and Stakeholders.
- Conduct Public Safety Meetings and Seminars with downtown building tenants and businesses.
- Liaison with Law Enforcement agencies; DPD, DART, DHS, and FBI to ensure intelligence / incident information is delivered to Downtown Stakeholders in a timely manner.

- Facilitate specialized terrorism behavior awareness training for Safety Patrol, Private Security, DPD, and DART Officers working downtown.

Personnel Goals

- Reduce annual employee turnover below 10%.
- Decrease employee related bicycle/patrol accidents. Hold Monthly Safety Meetings and publish Newsletter Articles regarding safe riding and patrol habits.
- Implement 40 Hour Annual Refresher Training for Safety Patrol Officers.

Homeless Initiatives

- Partner with Crisis Intervention to engage the Top 50 homeless individual's downtown.
- Continue with Homeward Bound Program; send 250 homeless to home States.
- Add Crisis Intervention Caseworker Team to Safety Patrol evening shift.
- Direct Off Duty DPD Patrol Officers to enforce zero tolerance for sleeping, drinking, and urinating in public.
- Direct homeless individuals to The Bridge for outreach services.
