Crawford was named President and Chief Executive Officer of **DOWNTOWN**DALLAS in 2007, after serving as the volunteer Chairman of the Board of Directors in 2006. **DOWNTOWN**DALLAS is a private non-profit organization serving as the primary advocate and champion for Downtown, ensuring that Downtown grows as a vibrant center of urban life, recognized locally and globally for the quality of its business, hospitality, entertainment, living and cultural environments.

John Crawford brings to **DOWNTOWN**DALLAS over 30 years of successful marketing and general management experience as a senior executive with four Fortune 500 firms, and experience as a professional services executive, consultant and principal with firms in the legal, financial services, insurance and real estate development/brokerage industries. His experience also includes serving on the development team of the two largest real estate projects in the downtown area - the 1.7 million square foot Bank of America Plaza and the 1.4 million square foot Cityplace.
