

DOWNTOWNDALLAS and American Institute of Architects Dallas Hold Competition for A Facelift on the Statler Hilton

DOWNTOWNDALLAS, in partnership with the American Institute of Architects Dallas (AIA), is coordinating a design competition for a temporary structure or artwork to cover the facade of the first floor of the vacant old Statler Hilton hotel. The motivation for the competition is to find a creative, visually stimulating cover for the vacant storefront of the hotel in time for the Main Street Garden grand opening in October.

The competition has stipulated that any design or materials cannot attach to the building so as not to disturb its historical integrity. Out of 45 submissions, jurors will analyze and select what they believe is the best, most feasible and attractive design. The winner will be announced mid-August.
