

Downtown Dallas Brownfield Cleanup

The City of Dallas will host a public meeting to receive comments on two grant proposals to be submitted to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG) for the Brownfields Cleanup Program and NCTCOG Brownfields Revolving Loan Fund (RLF) Program, respectfully. The City of Dallas is pursuing EPA funding to remove contaminants from 1014 and 1100 Main Street located on the block bounded by Main Street, Griffin Street, Commerce Street and Field Street in downtown Dallas.

The meeting will be held at 6 pm, October 7th at 1200 Main Street in the Community Room of The Metropolitan.

The grant proposal will be available for review and comment at the meeting and at Dallas City Hall, 1500 Marilla Street, 6FN, Dallas, Texas 75201 between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm Monday through Friday from October 1, - October 12, 2009.
